A 12- or 13-year-old does not need to know whether they will one day study in Spain, work internationally or use Spanish in a way none of us can predict today.

Learning Spanish earlier gives a young person something valuable now: the capability to make choices later without language closing the door.

We modelled one illustrative progression through long-term Spanish preparation, a one-year university-access pathway in Valencia and potential progression to a Spanish public university.

STAGE	WORKING MODEL	WHAT IT MEANS
Spanish with Vamos	Up to 350 hours	Long-term preparation towards approximately B1.
Academic profile	5 GCSEs + 2 A levels	Entry requirement in the Hispania pathway modelled here.
University-access pathway	One academic year in Valencia	PCE preparation and Spain-side support.
Public university	Typically modelled over 4 years	Degree options depend on academic record and pathway/entrance results.

What could it cost?

The purpose of modelling the journey is to let families and schools see the scale of the commitment - not simply the possibility.

COST AREA	CURRENT WORKING FIGURE	HOW TO READ IT
Spanish preparation	Around £3,000	Based on up to 350 hours with Vamos.
University-access pathway	From €4,500	One academic year in Valencia.
Living costs	€750-€1,000 / month	Estimated monthly living costs in Valencia.
Public-university tuition	Approx. €1,000 / year	Typical tuition; varies by university and degree.
Potential part-time earnings	€8,400-€9,600 / year	Illustrative only; subject to work availability.
